Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Bloomfield Public Transportation System is required by law to post Title VI notices on our agency's website, public areas of our agency, our board room, and our buses.

Bloomfield Public Transportation System operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Bloomfield Public Transportation System, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Bloomfield Public Transportation System:

- To obtain a copy of the Title VI complaint form go to cityofbloomfield.net and select this form under Transit section.
- In addition to the complaint process at Bloomfield Public Transportation System, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region, and Bloomfield Public Transportation.
- Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
- 4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.

If information is needed in another language, contact 573-568-3960. Interested persons may submit orally, or in writing, evidence and recommendations, with respect to said project.

If noperson request to give either oral or written evidence three days prior to the hearing Bloomfield Public Translt is not required to hold the public hearing.
