Read one time and a motion was made by Ald. Wilson and second by Ald. Haley to allow a second read. Motion carried 3-0. Read a second time and Ald. Haley moved to approve Bill #2021-011. Ald. Wilson second the motion. Ayes - 3, Nays - 0.

Ald. Haley moved to have the City apply for funding from the CDBG-CV grant. Ald. Clary second. Motion passed 3-0.

DPS Director Dew stated that he had received several complaints of dogs being at the park unleashed, or the owners not cleaning up after their dog(s), or vicious dogs. Council will review similar ordinances pertaining to dogs at the park from other cities and discuss again at the August meeting.

Justin Bell was given council approval to check on pricing and grant availability in replacing the water department's Ford F250.

Other Matters: Discussion on paving certain areas at the park was put on hold until the August meeting.
