## Bloomfield City Council Meeting Regular Session Nov. 20, 2023 at 6:30pm

Council members present were Pat Wilson, Rachel Clary, Cecil Haley, Donna Deardorff. City Attorney Robin Northern was absent. The mayor called the meeting to order and lead with the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence.

<u>Public Comments</u>: Toni Wheetley commented there were no parking available on the west side of the courthouse since the new 2-hour parking signs had been put in place. Employees working in the old courthouse could not park there anymore. Mayor Aslin explained where alternative parking was located. Question was raised about another handicap parking slot around the courthouse.

Bo McCollum, 708 N Prairie, requested permission to place a new double-wide trailer on the backside of his property, facing N Viola. Stated a concrete pad would be done in December and the trailer placed in January. Ald. Wilson to allow for the placement of a new double-wide trailer be placed on said property, as long as the City's ordinance on trailer requirements was followed. Ald. Deardorff seconded the motion. All in favor 4-0 vote.

<u>Consent Agenda</u>: Ald. Haley moved and second by Ald. Clary to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed 4 - 0 vote.

<u>Updates:</u> DPS/Comm. bldg - project is on schedule. Park grant – hope to have a cultural resource survey completed in December. Basement remodel – in progress.

<u>Unfinished Bus</u>: Discussion had on the pros and cons of having all city vehicles marked with either a plate or decal. Ald. Haley moved to have city plates on all city vehicles except for the dps director's. Ald. Clary second. Roll call vote taken:

C. Haley – aye
D. Deardorff – naye

R. Clary – aye
P. Wilson – naye

Since there was a tie vote of 2 -2, the mayor broke the tie voting aye as well.

Bill #2023.14 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, MISSOURI, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION WHICH NEW SECTION SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 355.015 OF CHAPTER 355 OF TITLE: STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN SPECIFIED PLACES. Ald. Deardorff moved, and Ald. Haley seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion passed 4 - 0. Ald. Haley moved to approve Bill #2023.14. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. Bill passed unanimously 4 – 0.

**New Bus:** Bill #2023.15 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 3149 OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, MISSOURI, GRANTING A CABLE SYSTEM FRANCHISE, ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, MISSOURI, GRANTING CABLE SYSTEM FRANCHISES, AND ALL MODIFICATIONS, EXTENSIONS AND TRANSFERS THEREOF. Ald. Deardorff moved, and Ald. Haley seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion passed 4-0. Ald. Haley moved to approve Bill #2023.15. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. Bill passed unanimously 4-0.

Bill #2023.16 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH LEMONS LANDFILL, LLC AND BUTLER COUNTY LANDFILL, LLC. Ald. Deardorff moved, and Ald. Wilson seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion passed 4-0. Ald. Clary moved to approve Bill #2023.16. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. Bill passed unanimously 4-0.

Bill #2023.17 AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING PROPOSAL OF TRILEAF CORPORATION FOR PHASE I CULTURAL RESOURCES SURVEY FOR APPROXIMATELY THREE (3) ACRES WITHIN THE BLOOMFIELD CITY PARK AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID PROPOSAL. Ald. Clary moved, and Ald. Haley seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion passed 4 – 0. Ald. Haley moved to approve Bill #2023.17. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. Bill passed unanimously 4 – 0.

Bill #2023.18 AN ORDINANCE SETTING ELECTION FOR TWO ALDERMEN ON APRIL 2, 2024. Ald. Haley moved, and Ald. Clary seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion passed 4-0. Ald. Haley moved to approve Bill #2023.17. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. Bill passed unanimously 4-0.

Ald. Haley moved to allow the purchase of a breathing air compressor from Hoffcomp for approximately \$34,712.00. Ald. Clary seconded the motion. All in favor 4 - 0.

Ald. Deardorff motioned to accept a five year contract with Axxon for body cameras with an annual of \$6594.76. Ald. Wilson seconded the motion. All in favor 4 - 0.

Ald. Deardorff moved to allow the city's operating account at Southern Bank be placed in ICS with a peg of \$750,000. Ald. Wilson seconded the motion. Motion carried with 3 voting aye and 1 abstained due to conflicts of interest.

Ald. Haley motioned to enter executive session per 610.021(1)(3). Ald. Clary seconded. All in favor 4 - 0.

Back in regular session. No action taken in executive session.

Ald. Haley moved to approve the invoice from Semo Electric in the amount of \$31,6779.00 for providing services to the new building site. Ald. Clary second. Motion passed 3 – 0 due to Ald Wilson leaving unexpectedly.
