

Bloomfield City Council Meeting  
Regular Session  
Sept. 18,2023 at 6:30pm

Council members present were Pat Wilson, Rachel Clary and Donna Deardorff. Cecil Haley along with City Attorney Robin Northern were absent. The mayor called the meeting to order and lead with the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence.

**Public Comments:** none

**Presentation:** Debbie Johns, with Van De Ven, CPAs, presented the results from the 06/30/2022 audit. She stated that the City got a clean report and is doing good.

**Consent Agenda:** Ald. Deardorff moved and second by Ald. Wilson to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed 3-0 vote.

**Updates:** DPS/Comm. Bldg: Project is on schedule. Expect the building shell to be up in 6-8 weeks. Next progress meeting is Oct. 13 at 9:00am.

**New Bus:** Bill #2023.12 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH HAAS CONTRACTING, LLC. Ald. Clary moved, and Ald. Deardorff seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion carried 3-0. Ald. Wilson moved and Ald. Clary second to approve Bill #2023.12. ayes – 3, nays – 0.

Bill #2023.13 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023. Ald. Deardorff moved, and Ald. Wilson seconded to allow for a second reading. Motion carried 3-0. Ald. Wilson moved and Ald. Clary second to approve Bill #2023.13. ayes – 3, nays – 0.

Ald. Clary made a motion to allow the City Clerk and the Water Clerk to move forward with switching out the debit/credit machine to a company that has programmable machines that automatically add the user fee and has lower monthly fees for the City. Ald. Deardorff seconded the motion. All in favor 3-0.

**Other Matters** Discussion was had on the parking situation on the west side of the courthouse square. New businesses would like to have reserved parking spots for their customers. Chief Dew will discuss this further with City Attorney Robin Northern.

Ald. Clary motioned and Ald. Deardorff second to table the discussion of decals for city vehicles until the October meeting. Motion passed.

Ald. Wilson motioned to enter executive session per 610.021(3). Ald. Clary seconded. All in favor.
